VETERANS ELEMENTARY ACHIEVES LEADER IN ME LIGHTHOUSE STATUS

(MACON, GA) – Veterans Elementary School has earned Lighthouse School status from Leader in Me. This designation recognizes the school for implementation of Leader in Me principles, including the "7 Habits of Highly Effective People," in every phase of school life.

"The students, staff, and community stakeholders at Veterans Elementary School truly embrace Stephen Covey's philosophy that every child has genius and that everyone who aspires to lead can be a leader," said Principal Dr. Arrika Tunstell.
